#### MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

- **Proof of completion of your undergraduate studies**  
Certificates from your undergraduate studies: Bachelor's certificate/degree certificate and, if applicable, a supplementary Transcript of Records and the Diploma Supplement
  - **Certificates or Transcripts of Records of advanced studies**  
Transcripts of records or certificates of your further studies
  - **Certificate of study or exmatriculation**
- ➔ **NON-EU-APPLICANTS:**
- **All the above listed documents and, if applicable, further documents in original language and certified translation (German or English)**
  - **Proof of German language proficiency/passed German language test (TestDaf 16 points, DSH level 2 or 3 a.o., further at RUB accepted proofs see infobox at <https://studium.ruhr-uni-bochum.de/en/application-international-prospective-students>) [except for English-only degree programmes!]**

for a semester at RUB lower than the one applied for

if admission is granted based on an order for interim relief by the court

## SUBJECT-SPECIFIC DOCUMENTS

- **Cognitive Science**

Proof of sufficient English language skills

At least at level B2 (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) is required. The following tests are accepted: UNlcert II (grade 2.0 or better), IELTS 6.5 (with at least a 6.0 in all four sub-categories), TOFL IBT 85 (with at least 18 in all four sub-categories), FCE (grade A or B, resp. C or B2).

- **Economic Policy Consulting, FAACT, Management and Economics**

- Formal record of recognition of prior learning, issued by the respective examination office at RUB

- Proof of sufficient English language skills

At least level B2 CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference): German Abitur (English for 8 years), Bachelor`s degree with English being the medium of instruction, TOEFL with a minimum total score of 87 points (internet-based) or equivalent (applications without proof cannot be considered)

- **Psychology, specialising in Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy**

Proof of bachelor's degree according to the Licensing Regulations for Psychotherapists (PsychThApprO):

Confirmation from your university that the bachelor's degree was awarded in accordance with the Psychotherapists Act (PsychThG) and the Licensing Regulations for Psychotherapists (PsychThApprO) (either by means of subsequent qualifications or professional recognition) and that all required content has been completed in accordance with §§ 7 and 9 PsychThG and §§ 13-15 and Annex 1 PsychThApprO.

Insofar as the requirements were fulfilled through subsequent qualifications: an overview from your university, showing in which modules or subsequent qualifications the knowledge and internship areas of the PsychThApprO were covered

- **Sales Management**

Formal record of recognition of prior learning, issued by the respective examination office at RUB

- **Work, Organizational and Business Psychology**

Relevant knowledge in the field of Work and Organizational (WO) Psychology

A bachelor's thesis in a relevant field of WO Psychology, alternatively a relevant internship in the field of WO Psychology or a relevant professional activity in this field (provided by a copy of the cover sheet of the bachelor's thesis/a copy of the internship reference/a copy of the employment reference)
