

THE COORDINATION RULES IN THE DIALOG-ORIENTED SERVICE PROCEDURE (DOSV)

1ST RULE

REQUIREMENTS:

- There is exactly one application.
- An admission offer has been made for the application.



AUTOMATIC ACTION:

- The admission offer becomes an admission.



2ND RULE

REQUIREMENTS:

- There are several applications.
- Admission offers have been made for all applications.



AUTOMATIC ACTION:

- The admission offer for the Priority 1 application becomes an admission immediately.
- All other applications are immediately eliminated.



3RD RULE

REQUIREMENTS:

- There are several applications.
- At least one admission offer has been made.
- There is no admission offer (yet) for at least one-application.



AUTOMATIC ACTION:

- Admission offers with a lower priority are eliminate immediately.
- The admission offer for the Priority 1 application is still available.
- All applications without an offer of admission are still valid.



4TH RULE

REQUIREMENTS:

- An admission offer for an application has been received.

The 4th rule only takes effect in the last days of the coordination phase and in the coordinated succession procedure.



AUTOMATIC ACTION:

- The admission offer is immediately turned into an admission.
- Prioritization is no longer relevant.
